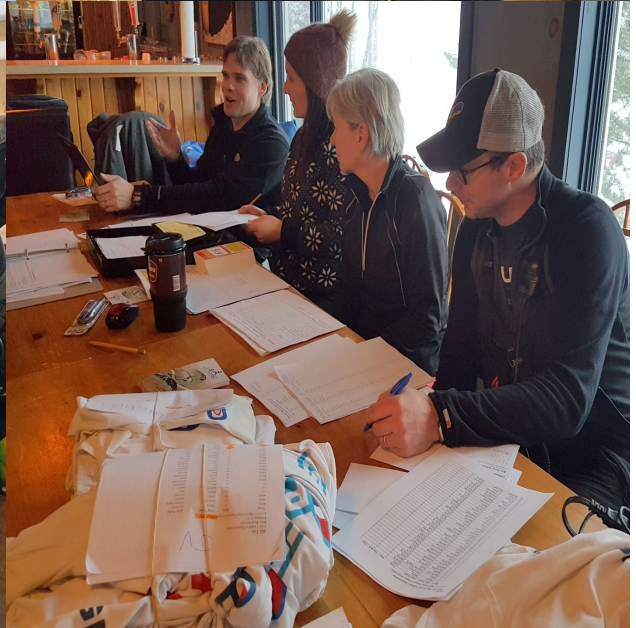


Alpine Skiing
